BEFORE YOU COME TO LAB

- **Prepare in advance.** Please read the lab material before coming to the lab.
- **Be punctual.** Please arrive at CL115 at least five minutes before your scheduled lab. Attendance will be taken at the start of the lab.

PUNCTUALITY | If you are not punctual, you will not receive the attendance mark.

MARKING & SUBMISSION

- **In-person marking.** Lab marking is done only in person during your scheduled lab. This ensures that you understand your work and are responsible for what you submit.

IMPORTANT | Work submitted to UR Courses without corresponding attendance in the lab will not be marked.
